



## **Terms & Conditions for Proof-Of-Concept Scheme**

1. Any entity that is interested in participating in the Singapore Satellite Positioning Reference Network (SiReNT) Proof-of-Concept Scheme (POCS), may submit on the SiReNT web portal (<https://app1.sla.gov.sg/sirent/>) stating full details of the project. Please note that only projects to be implemented in Singapore are eligible for participation in the POCS.
2. A participant in the POCS, may access and use the Real Time Kinematic Service or Differential Global Positioning System Service for free for a period of three months or as otherwise agreed between the participant and SLA, only for the purpose(s) of the project stipulated in the application (and not for any commercial purpose whatsoever, whether in Singapore or elsewhere).
3. All participants in the POC Scheme must:
  - i) Within thirty (30) days after the expiry of the trial period, provide a report on the SiReNT web portal to SLA setting out the results which SLA has requested;
  - ii) Display a SLA / SiReNT logo on the platform / equipment / device in which SiReNT is used in the POCS;
  - iii) Schedule site visits for SLA if requested; &
  - iv) Provide any information of the project when requested by SLA.
4. SLA reserves the right to terminate a participant's participation in the POCS at any time upon giving three (3) days' notice to the participant.
5. A participant may terminate its participation in the POCS only with SLA's prior written consent.
6. SLA reserves the right to publish any information about any participants who have participated in the POCS, and their projects.
7. SLA may, from time to time, amend, vary, or withdraw the POCS, without prior notice.
8. The above Terms & Conditions may be amended or varied by SLA at any time, without prior notice, and are not binding on and do not form part of any offer or contract with SLA.
9. SLA may, at its absolute discretion, approve or reject any proposal to participate in the POCS.

If a proposal is approved by SLA, the participant shall be required to enter into a formal agreement with SLA, containing such terms and conditions governing his participation in the POCS as may be required by SLA.
